**PRESS NOTE**

**Special Intensive Revision in West Bengal**

The Constitution of India is supreme. All citizens, political parties and the Election Commission of India follow the Constitution.

1. Article 326 specifies eligibility to become an elector. Only Indian citizens, above 18 years and ordinary resident in that constituency, are eligible.

2. Special Intensive Revision(SIR) has already started successfully in West Bengal for verifying the eligibility of each elector with full participation of all Political parties.

3. West Bengal has **80,681** Booth Level Officers (BLOs)

4. BLO Supervisors/ BLO's/Govt. servants will be assisting genuine electors, particularly the old, sick, Persons with Disabilities (PwD), poor and other vulnerable groups during the SIR.

5. All recognised National and State Political Parties who are registered with ECI have already appointed more than 63 thousand Booth Level Agents (BLAs). Each political party has once again been requested by the DEOs to appoint one BLA per booth as far as possible.

6. Door-to-door distribution of Enumeration Forms (EF) in duplicate for all the existing **7,66,37,529** electors of West Bengal has already started in each of the 294 Assembly Constituencies of West Bengal.

7. Out of the 7,66,37,529 electors of West Bengal in the Electoral Roll (as on 27.10.2025 midnight) those whose names are already there in the last Intensive Revision of Electoral Roll of West Bengal as on 01.01.2002 or in the last Intensive Revision of other States (in 2002, 2003 etc as the case may be) will have to simply include the details in the Enumeration Form and submit it.
8. No paper will be collected by the BLO and BLA from any elector during House to House visit.
9. Two copies of EF will be handed over to each elector by BLO and after filling up by the elector one copy will be returned with acknowledgement by the BLO to the elector and the other copy will be retained by the BLO.
10. Enumeration Forms in duplicate have been handed over to more than 18 lakh number of electors upto 5pm during the first day of House to House visit on 04.11.2025
11. During SIR DEOs and EROs are engaging all the BLOs full time for house to house visit from 4.11.25 till 4.12.2025
12. Help Desks have been set up in all offices of the 24 DEOs, 294 EROs and 341 BDOs/AEROs to facilitate the electors.
13. Message of the Chief Electoral Officer and District Election Officers have been disseminated in all audio visual media and social media platforms for the information of all the electors.
14. All Activities relating to SIR are progressing well as per schedule in West Bengal.
